


THE CHAMELEON

A CAREER THAT SPANS 6 DECADES

Harvey Mason is among the most recorded and in-demand drummers of all-time. A legendary, multi-GRAMMY® nominated session and touring drummer, producer, composer & recording artist, he has worked with a pantheon of musical giants, including Quincy Jones, Barbra Streisand, James Brown, Herbie Hancock, Beyonce, Christina Aguilera, Usher, Jennifer Hudson, Frank Sinatra, Ray Charles, Bjork, Carlos Santana, Michael Jackson, John Legend, Seal, and the London Symphony Orchestra. He has composed and written songs recorded by artists ranging from Nancy Wilson and Mary J. Blige to The Notorious B.I.G., Lupe Fiasco, Nelly/P. Diddy and T.I. Yes, Harvey has won four 1st place plaques from Modern Drummer magazine's annual studio poll and has been the first call drummer for the Academy Awards ceremonies on 25 occasions.

HARVEY MASON'S CHAMLEON

As one of popular music's most renowned drummers, **Harvey**

Mason has amassed an incredible resume that befits a legendary performer. He possesses the rare ability to play with a wide range of musicians in a variety of styles, from high-grade straight-up pop to stimulating straight-ahead jazz to smooth, R&B-flavored jazz. On the threshold of entering his fifth decade as an oftentimes behind-thescenes star, Mason continues to deliver his stylistic innovation as a master of the drum set.

FOURPLAY SUPERGROUP

PREMIER SMOOTH JAZZ

For nearly two decades, the contemporary jazz quartet known as *f*OURPLAY has enjoyed consistent artistic and commercial success by grafting elements of R&B, pop and a variety of other sounds to their unwavering jazz foundations. In the course of ten recordings – five of which have climbed to the top of Billboard's Contemporary Jazz Album charts – the supergroup has continued to explore the limitless dimensions and permutations of jazz while at the same time appealing to a broad mainstream audience.







25 YEARS STRONG


The fOURPLAY story begins in 1990, with keyboardist Bob James, who had already established himself as a formidable figure in keyboard jazz – not just as an instrumentalist but as a composer and arranger as well – with solo recordings dating as far back as the mid 1960s. In 1990, James reunited with his old friend, session drummer Harvey Mason (Herbie Hancock, Sergio Mendes, James Brown), during the recording of James' "Grand Piano Canyon" album. Also involved in the project were guitarist Lee Ritenour (Sergio Mendes) and bassist/vocalist Nathan East (Barry White, Eric Clapton, Phil Collins).



JAZZ/TAKES SUPERGROUP

EUROPEAN TOUR 2023

The JAZZ/TAKES SUPERGROUP plays a mixture of their own compositions and jazz interpretations of top songs from genres like 90s grunge (Pearl Jam, Soundgarden, Alice In Chains, Nirvana, Soundgarden), 70s disco (Chic, Abba, Sister Sledge), French Electronic (David Guetta), Heavy Metal (Metallica), 90s Hip Hop (Nas, Notorious B.I.G., A Tribe Called Quest), 70s NY Post Punk (Television, Patti Smith, The Ramones), 80's UK New Wave (New Order) and more.

SULTAN of FUNK & GROOVE



Harvey William Mason was born in Atlantic City, New Jersey, in 1947 and developed an interest in drumming at a young age. He studied performance, composition, arranging, and percussion at both Berklee College of Music and the New England Conservatory of Music. Since starting his career in the '70s, Mason has released many albums, producing some of them as well as composing the music. In 1979, he released a hit single, "Groovin' You," from the album of the same name, and he has recorded everything from jazz to religious works to jingles.
